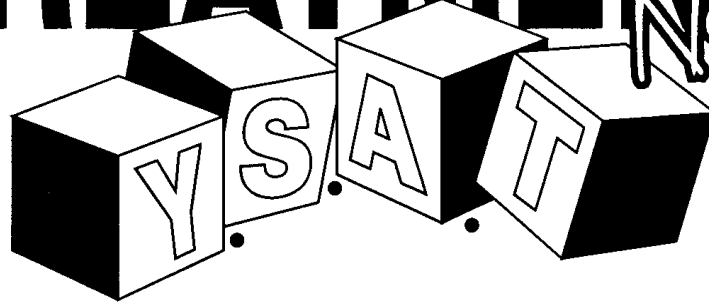

This directory was compiled by the N. KY. Youth Substance Abuse Treatment Collaborative (YSAT). We are a collaborative comprised of community leaders including individuals from the Department of Juvenile Justice, Department of Community Based Services, Court Designated Workers, school officials, police, clergy, substance abuse prevention and treatment providers, and youth advocates. We have listed youth substance abuse prevention and treatment services, as well as support services, and community groups, in our region. Since N. KY. does not have a detox, inpatient or residential program for adolescents, statewide options are listed.

As with any medical treatment, please contact your health insurance carrier for the providers covered in your policy. Many policies have no or limited coverage for substance abuse treatment. Some treatment providers have a sliding scale fee. Others will arrange a payment policy. Some treatment providers can bill for youth substance abuse services under a program called Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment (EPSDT), which is part of Medicaid. (Except for pregnant women up to 60 days post partum, adult substance abuse services are not covered under Medicaid.) K-CHIP also covers some youth substance abuse services.

## Section 1: What do you do when your child is drinking and/or using drugs?

Being proactive is the best approach to keeping your child substance free. Talk early and often with your children regarding your feelings about underage drinking and substance use. NorthKey's Regional Prevention Center teaches a program called Prime for Parents, which shows parents how to reduce a child's risk, as well as signs and symptoms of use. It is also important that you clearly state what the consequences will be if your child uses substances. If your child uses alcohol and/or other substances, enforce the consequences. If use continues, a logical consequence is enrolling your child in a prevention program **that includes a screening component**. As a parent, be prepared to participate in this program. (Prevention programs are generally low cost, but are not covered by insurance.)

**DO NOT** ignore underage drinking or marijuana use. From a legal perspective, your child is engaging in illegal activities, which could result in an arrest. From a health perspective, substance use at a young age affects brain development and could make the child more susceptible to addiction. From a safety perspective, many youth are hurt or killed, or make suicide attempts, while under the influence of substances.

If your child needs further assessment and/or treatment, the first call is to your insurance company to determine your coverage, as well as the treatment providers they will cover. In Kentucky, substance abuse treatment for minors is covered under a Medicaid program called Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment (EPSDT), as well as some levels of KY Children's Health Insurance Program (KCHIP). If your private health insurance will not provide coverage, ask the treatment provider if they will work with you on a payment plan or assist you in finding other support.

### ***When you begin calling treatment providers, here are some tips:***

1. Keep the information you receive from your insurance company and treatment provider organized. Otherwise, you will soon be overwhelmed with information.
2. When you call the treatment provider, ask for the intake worker.
3. Be persistent. If the intake worker is not available, ask for that person's name and alternate contacts (direct line, cell phone, etc.) Also, ask if there is an alternate person to speak with.
4. Try to talk to the same person if you need to call back. This saves you from explaining your situation again. Also, it helps to build a relationship with the person, which could benefit you later.

- Brief adolescent (12-17) substance abuse screening - screening process is offered in a group setting with the parent/guardian required to attend in order to determine substance use and abuse.
- After the screening determines appropriate service level, youth is referred to either the intensive educational sessions (offered by Early Intervention Program personnel) or for further assessment services.
- The EIP is 5 sessions, 1 session is with parents and youth.
- Follow-up and compliance correspondence is sent to the referral source.

- Referrals must be between the ages of 16 and 20 in addition to receiving a blood alcohol level between 0.02-0.08.
- Underage DUI charges that meet the above qualifications **must** go through the Zero Tolerance Program offered through the RPC in order to regain their operator's license.
- It is the referral source's responsibility to assist in the youth's compliance with the program.
