RESOLUTION NO. 2020-07

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE GRANTING OF AN INDUCEMENT TO WOLF STEEL ACQUISITION LLC, OR IT'S SUCCESSORS OR AFFILIATES, PURSUANT TO THE KENTUCKY BUSINESS INVESTMENT ACT (KRS SUBCHAPTER 154.32), WHEREBY THE GRANT COUNTY FISCAL COURT AGREES TO REBATE ANNUALLY ONE PERCENT (1%) OF THE COMPANY'S OCCUPATIONAL TAXES FOR A TERM OF NO LONGER THAN TEN (10)YEARS FROM THE ACTIVATION DATE, SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS CONTAINED IN THE ACT AND ANY AGREEMENT WITH THE KENTUCKY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AUTHORITY OR THE GRANT COUNTY FISCAL COURT RELATED TO THE PROJECT AND TAKING OTHER RELATED ACTION.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has created the Kentucky Business Investment program pursuant to KRS Subchapter 154.32 (the "Act") to induce the creation of certain qualifying projects that would create jobs in Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority has preliminarily approved the participation of Wolf Steel Acquisition, LLC, in the Kentucky Business Investment Program (the "Program"); and

WHEREAS, the Grant County Fiscal Court is willing to approve the granting of an inducement to Wolf Steel Acquisition, LLC or it's successors or affiliates), pursuant to the Act, whereby it would rebate annually to the Company one per cent (1%) of the occupational tax that would otherwise be due to it related to the employees who meet the requirements of the program, which shall be retained by Wolf Steel Acquisition, LLC for a term of no longer than ten (10) years from the activation date established by the Program, subject to the limitations contained in the Act and any agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GRANT COUNTY FISCAL COURT

Section 1 – That the preamble to this Resolution is incorporated herein as if set out in full. Section 2 - That the granting of an inducement to Wolf Steel Acquisition, LLC, or its successors or affiliates as may be approved by the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority initially or in the future Wolf Steel Acquisition, LLC), be and hereby is approved. Section 3 - That pursuant to the Kentucky Business Investment Program and KRS 154.32-090, the Grant County Fiscal Court hereby agrees to rebate annually to the Company one percent (1%) of the occupational taxes due from and remitted by the Company from the wages of those employees whose jobs meet the criteria related to the qualifying project under the program (as determined by the Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority), for a term of no longer than ten (10) years from the activation date established by the program, subject to the limitations contained in the Act, any agreement the Company has with the Grant County Fiscal Court as related to the project, and the submission of necessary documentation.

Section 4 – That the Judge/Executive and all members of the Grant County Fiscal Court, and other appropriate officers and employees of the Grant County Fiscal Court are hereby authorized to execute, acknowledge and deliver any agreements, documents and such other instruments and papers and to take such other actions as may be necessary or desirable, on behalf of the Grant County Fiscal Court to effect the transactions authorized above.

Section 5 – That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.

605 Military Leave

Effective Date: 7/1/2020

A military leave of absence will be granted to employees who are absent from work because of service in the U.S. uniformed services in accordance with the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act (USERRA) and in accordance with and pursuant to KRS 61.394, which states as follows:

"All officers and employees of this state, or of any department or agency thereof who are members of the National Guard or of any reserve component of the Armed Forces of the United States, or of the reserve corps of the United States Public Health Service, shall be entitled to leave of absence from their respective duties, without loss of time, pay, regular leave, impairment of efficiency rating, or of any other rights or benefits to which they are entitled, while in the performance of duty or training in the service of a state or of the United States under competent orders as specified in this section. In any one (1) federal fiscal year, officers or employees, while on military leave, shall be paid their salaries or compensations for a period or periods not exceeding twenty-one (21) calendar days. Any unused military leave in a federal fiscal year shall be carried over to the next year. Any unused military leave shall expire two (2) years after it has accrued."

Continuation of health insurance benefits is available as required by USERRA and KRS 61,394 based on the length of the leave and subject to the terms, conditions and limitations of the applicable plans for which the employee is otherwise eligible.

Employees on military leave are required to return to work for the first regularly scheduled shift after the end of service, allowing reasonable travel time. Employees no longer on military leave must apply for reinstatement in accordance with USERRA and all applicable state laws.

Employees returning from military leave will be placed in the position they would have attained had they remained continuously employed or a comparable one depending on the length of military service in accordance with USERRA. They will be treated as though they were continuously employed for purposes of determining benefits based on length of service.
