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How Do I...

Dispose of excess waste from cleaning out my garage, shed, etc?

- Excess waste from cleaning out your garage, shed, etc can be accomplished by utilizing our Spring and Fall Cleanup Events. This is also done through our curbside garbage collection program.
- Every Spring and Every Fall we hold a two week cleanup event that occurs on your normal garbage collection day. We advertise these dates in the Grant County News and on the County Social Media pages
 - The first week is for excess trash, garbage, bulky items and debris. Items must be bagged, boxed or bundled, neatly placed for pickup and the bundles must not exceed 75 lbs. Items will not be removed from trailers nor will piles of waste be picked up by the contractor.
 - The Second week is for appliance recycling. Place all non-freon containing appliances at the street with you normal garbage cans and the Contractor will send a second truck by to pick it up.
 - For Freon containing applicances (refrigerators, freezers, etc) please call the Grant County Solid Waste Management Office and schedule an appointment for us to pick it up during the Cleanup Week at 859-824-3050
