Dispose of Household Hazardous Waste?

- Grant County annually holds a Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Day. This event is funded by Grants from the Commonwealth of KY.
- Most common household items are collected such as petroleum fuels, cleaners, fertilizers, insecticides, weed killer etc.
- Several items cannot be accepted such as paint, motor oil, ordinances, ammunition, automotive batteries.
 - Paint – is not a hazardous material, it is prohibited from landfill disposal only in its liquid form. Dry up the paint to a “silly putty” consistency and put it in your normal curbside garbage.
 - Motor oil and Automotive Batteries can be returned to many garages and automotive parts stores.
