Motion was made by Magistrate Coldiron and seconded by Magistrate Humphrey to approve the regular meeting minutes of July 08, 2025. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Magistrate Riley and seconded by Magistrate Coldiron to approve all claims on the general fund, road fund and jail fund, along with all transfers presented dated July 15, 2025. All in favor, motion carried.

First Reading on Ordinance No. 0007-2025-0290, Street-Legal Special Purpose Vehicles (SLSPV). No action taken.
